

Donna goes above and beyond whenever she can, and consistently displays strengths specific to the Core Competencies, as detailed below.



Donna works with our service recipient in multiple environments, home, school, and community. She takes the time to assess his responses within these different environments and encourages him to problem solve; developing skills that he can utilize when she is not present. Donna began working with him as a 1:1 in his summer school program, and it was a transition for him to get accustomed to seeing her waiting at home for him as well. She was cognizant of these things and allowed for a transition period.

<u>Competency Area D: Facilitating personal growth and development</u>

In correlation to the above, Donna strongly demonstrates the ability to vary her teaching styles to best meet the needs of her service recipient. Her personal experiences with him and her willingness to explore and troubleshoot what works best for him, enables her to make adaptions where needed so each lessons/goals are meaningful.

Competency Area F: Building and maintaining relationships

Donna understands the importance of friendships and a sense of community and she encourages natural supports on an ongoing basis. She strives to get him out into the community. She encourages him to speak for himself while they are out, and reminds him of social nuances as needed.

Competency Area G: Creating meaningful communication

Encouraging our service recipient to build and maintain relationships couldn't be possible without also creating meaningful communication. She takes her time to establish trust and communicates empathetically. She scaffolds her support and has a way of communicating with him that is *special between them*. She interprets his body language, his sounds, and his attempts at different words that others may not understand. She facilitates communication with others when needed; which helps him to overcome communication deficits that may otherwise prohibit his interactions with others. Donna doesn't speak for him, but she helps him speak for himself and this contributes to his self esteem and willingness to try and communicate more.

Competency Area H: Developing professional relationships

As previously stated, Donna is a member of her service recipients' team in several environments. She is mutually respectful with everyone, be it family, school personnel, other support professionals, her supervisors, etc. When the family needed more assistance, Donna found a second staff to work with him and she insisted on shadowing this staff to teach her "the ropes." She has taken a leading role, not for recognition, but for the well-being of her service recipient. There is immense sincerity in her work ethic that resonates strongly with our agency's mission.

Competency Area I: Exhibiting professional behavior

Donna is pleasant, punctual, reliable, and flexible. She handles her work with positivity and she is an absolute joy to have on my LI team.

Competency Area J: Showing respect for diversity and inclusion

Donna has respect for all peoples. She is especially genuine in her desire for the inclusion of those who have special needs. She is culturally competent given her many years of working as a 1:1 within school districts; however, even without her experience, she exudes innate compassion and overall awareness.

Competency Area O: Promoting positive behavior and supports

Donna has a great sense of humor and she has learned how to use it as a tool to re-direct our individual when he may get silly. He can test boundaries and she has a patient demeanor which is helpful when bringing him back to focus on a task. Donna is realistic in her expectations and she knows which days may be better than others to get desired outcomes. She fosters growth and development by recognizing how to support his positive behaviors and teaches him new behaviors to replace any current maladaptive displays. She also takes into consideration the hormonal transitions he is going through at his age and she <u>always</u> seeks the *function* of his behaviors before establishing a plan of action (to alleviate his frustrations and assure him that she understands his personal agenda and can assist him to make it socially appropriate when it may not be.) Donna knows how to re-direct him without embarrassment; she is sensitive to his feelings and to his happiness foremost.

Competency Area S: Supporting safety

Donna supports her service recipient's safety in everyday situations. She picks him up from the bus stop, from school, or other various activities. She must be there on time to ensure he has oversight and she reminds him consistently throughout their sessions to be mindful of his surroundings (especially in traffic/pedestrian situations.)

Competency Area V: Supporting active participation in the community

Donna takes her service recipient to his dances, sports, and other events. They also enjoy seasonal activities, like visiting holiday displays, pumpkin farms, and looking at Christmas lights. This summer, they went to the Long Island Aquarium, Queens Zoo, Adventureland Amusement Park, and the Tiki Action Park.
