POLL SITE LANGUAGE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The CEC makes voting more accessible for NYC voters with limited-English proficiency by expanding access to interpreters at select poll sites in the following languages:

- Arabic
- Bengali
- Chinese
- French
- Haitian Creole
- Italian
- Korean
- Polish
- Russian
- Urdu
- Yiddish

You have the right to vote in your language.

You may bring an interpreter to the voting booth. It can be a friend, family member, or poll worker. It cannot be your employer or union representative.

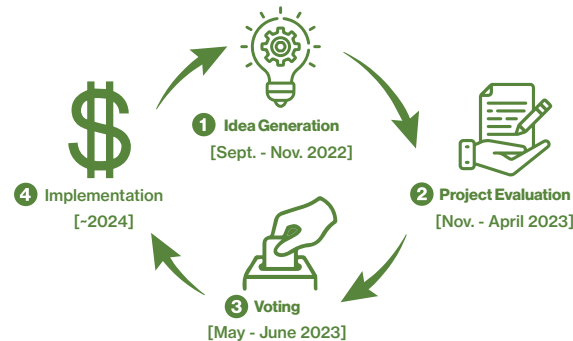

THE PEOPLE'S MONEY

The CEC implements a citywide participatory budgeting process in which all New Yorkers 11 years of age and older decide how to spend millions of dollars of the city budget for local community projects created, vetted, and voted on by the public.
